The Course – The Gospel in a Multi-Faith Culture (CPM 702) includes a wealth of resources for anyone interested in teaching or learning about how share our faith in a multi-faith culture. At the conclusion of this course, students will be able to articulate a Biblical theology of witness in a multi-faith culture; demonstrate the knowledge of basic skills for multi-faith witness and raise multi-faith witness awareness in a local church. Course Description

The Gospel in a Multi-faith Culture presents a broad and deep understanding of multi-faith cultures in both the old and new testaments of the bible; the biblical requirements for witness in a multi-faith culture and the strategies employed by God's people in the bible to reach others of different faith. CPM 702 meets only twelve times, with a different topic most of the weeks, which is why we encourage students to commit to attending all classes. In addition to the teachings and exercises presented in class, students practice how to share their faith with role-playing simulations that cover a range of topics including how to facilitate a multi-Faith awareness training in their churches.

Learning and grading in CPM 702 is based on: readings, class discussions and role plays, participation in the discussion forum, completing each week's assignments and the Missions Awareness project.
